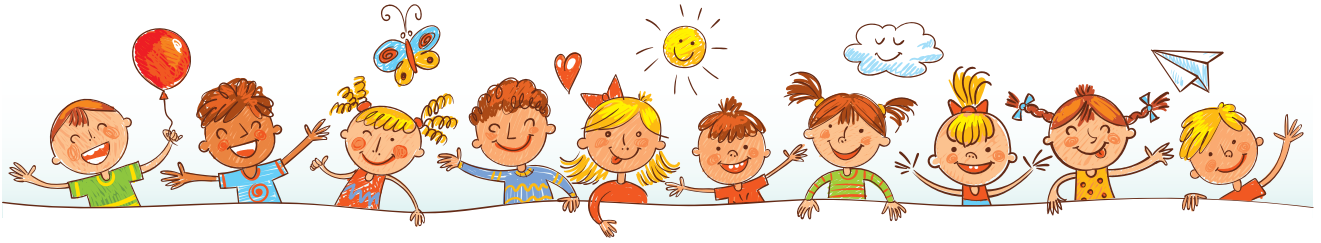

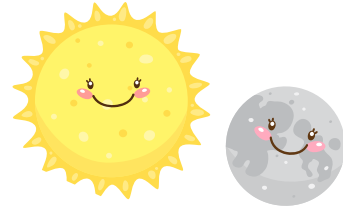

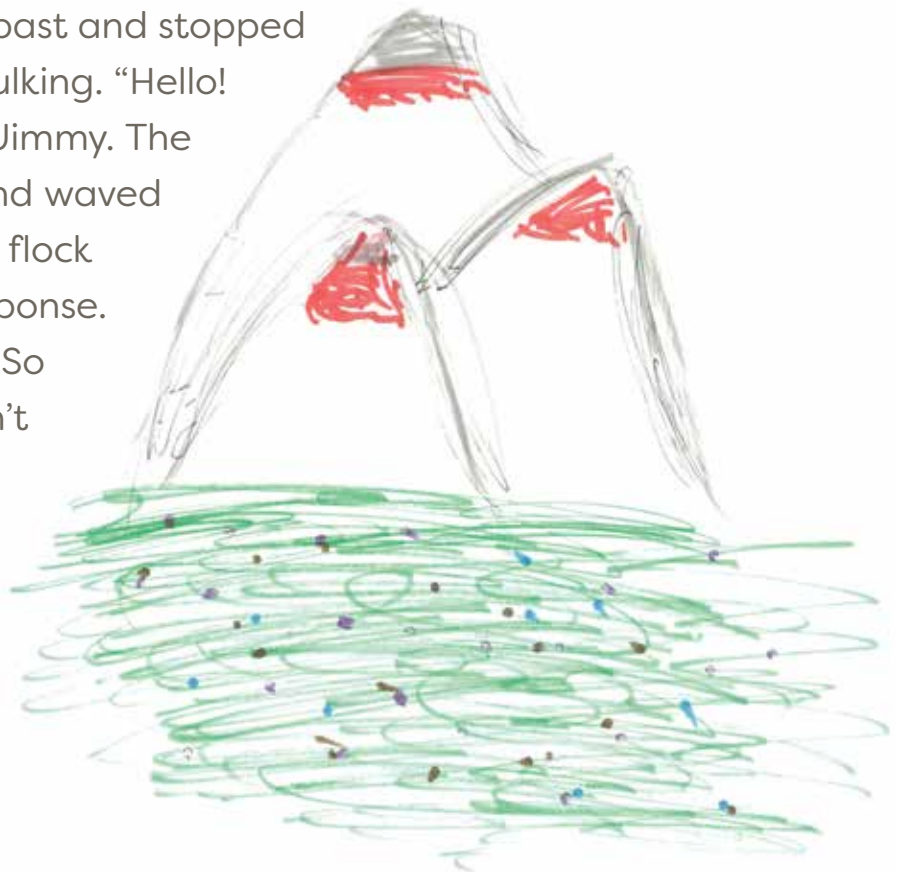

Planting Seeds of Friendship

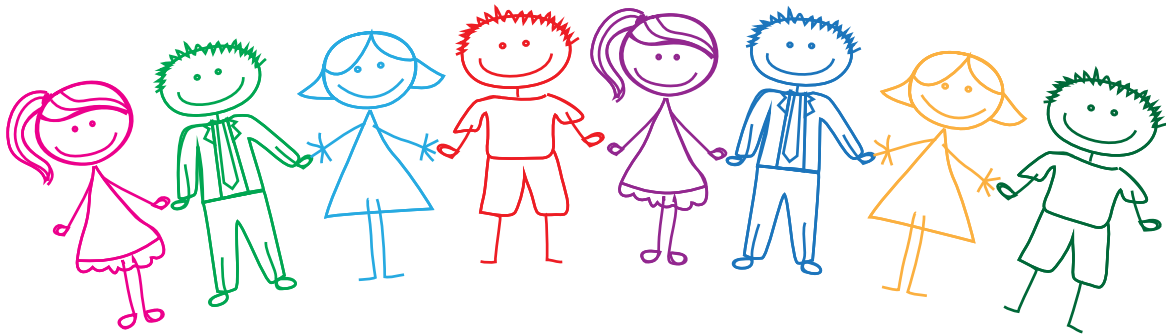

Let lessons be our teacher.

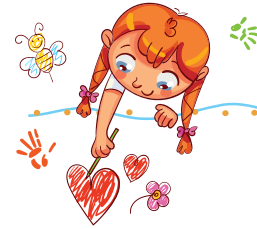
Help each other,
