WATCHING her friends have fun at the playground of Canossville Children's Home on National Day inspired Olivia Chua, 12, to point her camera at them.

The photograph which resulted - of her five friends on a dome-shaped playground structure - has won her the first prize in the under-16 category of a photo contest.

The theme of the competition organised by the Tan Chin Tuan Foundation was "My 24 hours: My Singapore, My

Home". The contest attracted about 3,000 photographs from 217 shutterbugs. The entries were all taken with disposable cameras, over 200 of which were handed out to beneficiaries of 20 organisations helped by the foundation.

They were given 24 hours to come back with photographs of National Day.
