

Puan Sri Helene Tan Chin Tuan Scholarship



Puan Sri Helene Tan, wife of Tan Sri (Dr) Tan Chin Tuan, was born in 1907 and educated at Methodist Girls' School (MGS). Between 1948 and 1963, Puan Sri Helene Tan's many senior appointments in voluntary organisations led her to become known as one of Singapore's most active charity workers. In 1951, she became President of the MGS Alumnae Association. She passed away in 1995. In 1998, her husband created a scholarship for MGS students in his late wife's name to commemorate her dedication to her family and society.
